



Pamela Gibson Emerging Visual Artist Micro-Grant

Purpose: *The Pamela Gibson Emerging Visual Artist Micro-Grant* provides up to \$300 to assist Workman Arts Artists members in realizing professional presentation opportunities outside of Workman Arts. Artists may apply to offset expenses for an exhibition or presentation project /event. Examples of eligible costs include festival fees, framing artwork, shipping of artwork, A/V equipment rental etc.. Presentation opportunity must be confirmed by a public venue.

Eligibility: This program is for Workman Arts Visual Artists members. Artists may apply once per year.

Application Deadline: The application is ongoing – you can apply any time. Applications will be reviewed at the end of each month. Applicants will be notified the first week of the following month.

Reporting: Artists are required to provide written feedback on how the project went and the impact of the grant. In addition, artists must provide copies of receipts or proofs of the expenses incurred and acknowledge ***Workman Arts Pamela Gibson Micro-Grant*** on all online and printed materials.
